- **Chaos (Pace Meltdown projected in Sec 1):** Win on Top AFS Closer (#21 Venetian Sun). Box Top 4 (#1, #21, #15, #10) in Exacta. Mandatory Trifecta Saver utilizing #15 Wise Approach underneath to inject massive value.

Quick Race Call & AI Verdict

- **Most Likely Winner:** #21 Venetian Sun — The unquestioned Neural Class boss who gets a dream tactical pace meltdown scenario up front.
- **Main Danger:** #1 Albert Einstein — Activated by "The Spine" and perfectly drawn/mapped to pick up the pieces if the closers get blocked.
- **Value/Chaos Threat:** #15 Wise Approach — Sits dead last early, but the Appleby runner has the elite finish speed to fly past a dying field at 20/1.
- **AI Call:** Expect Venetian Sun to prove best, with Albert Einstein the danger.
